Come for an afternoon or stay the night. Here are some ideas for a quick stop.

- Escape the ordinary in <u>Pittsburgh's Cultural District</u>. Liberty Magic is a 66-seat venue dedicated to the art of magic.



- Enjoy lunch and a sightseeing cruise aboard one of **The Gateway**Clipper Fleet's three vessels.
- Explore the <u>Northside | North Shore Chamber of Commerce</u> that includes many restaurants and attractions including <u>Shorty's Pins x</u>

 Pints and National Aviary.
- → Take in a panoramic view of Pittsburgh on the iconic <u>Duquesne Incline</u>. Spend the night with a view of the river at <u>Sheraton Pittsburgh Hotel at</u> <u>Station Square</u> before heading on your way.
- Make your stop in Pittsburgh one for the history books. The <u>Fort Pitt Museum</u>, located in picturesque Point State Park, tells the story of "The Point's" role in two wars, shaping the city. Boxed lunches can be delivered by <u>Gaetano's Catering and Event Center</u> for a picnic lunch. Head to the <u>Senator John Heinz History Center</u>, which explores more than 250 years of Western Pennsylvania's history.
- → Take a guided sightseeing tour of the city with <u>Molly's Trolleys</u> or customize your tour with <u>Passport to Pittsburgh</u> or <u>Rivers of Steel</u> <u>Heritage Tours.</u>
- Stretch your legs and your taste buds with a 'Burgh Bits and Bites Food Tour. Stop into visit with local business owners, learn the history of our neighborhoods, and delight in samples from each stop.
- Spend the day in Oakland visiting the equally stunning <u>Heinz Memorial</u>

 <u>Chapel</u> and <u>Phipps Conservatory and Botanical Gardens.</u> Overnight in the newly renovated <u>Courtyard Pittsburgh University Center</u> or at the industrial chic <u>Hotel Indigo Pittsburgh University-Oakland</u>
- → Lions, Tigers and Murals? Make a stop at the <u>Pittsburgh Zoo and Aquarium</u>. On your way stop in the Millvale neighborhood to see <u>The Vanka Murals</u> at St. Nicholas Church.
- → <u>Ross Park Mall</u>, a premier shopping destination with 170 specialty shops, anchored by Nordstrom, Macy's, and Dick's House of Sport.



GETTING HERE: Western Pennsylvania is near Pittsburgh International Airport and many major highways, such as I-70, I-76, I-79 & I-80. Making our region the perfect daytrip, overnight, stop along the way, and group destination.
